FUNDRAISERS

- Geranium Fundraiser- Schmidlin Greenhouse: There has been a slight increase in their prices for this spring; therefore, we may have to increase our selling prices to still make the same profit we have in the past.
 - Flats are going up 50 cents
 - Succulent and Mixed Bowls and galvanized pails going up \$1
 - Individuals going up \$3 per dozen
 - We buy by dozen, but sell individually
- We will increase prices accordingly, to \$4.
- We will see if the Greenhouse Effect will do Gift Cards again. Julie will check in January/February. Last year they furnished the gift cards.
