All outstanding tuition for this school year must be paid by Friday, May 6, 2016.



Ohio Laws for Child Restraints – Ohio state law requires motorists to restrain all children 4 – 8 years of age in a booster seat. This would include any student that is currently 8 years old. All children in a booster seat should be placed in the back seat of the vehicle.

Children older than 8 years of age are required to wear a seat belt. The state also recommends following the accepted standard of securing all children younger than 12 years in the rear seat of the vehicle.



Field trips begin next week. Please make sure that if your child is 8 years old or younger, they bring a booster seat to school on their field trip day.

They will not be allowed to travel in a car unless they have met these requirements. Thank you for your cooperation.
