

Classroom Spotlight

As we get into the heart of the school year, the fifth and sixth grade have had some great learning opportunities outside of the classroom. On September 22, we had the opportunity to go the annual field day held at the Paulding Fairgrounds where students learned about geology, animal habitats, water quality, honey bees, and many other interesting natural topics. Additionally, Michael Schweinsberg came to Divine Mercy on October 4, and together with the sixth graders from Payne Elementary, and the students participated in National Youth Science Day. The project involved making fitness trackers that the students were able to then use to monitor heart rate and also track their steps.

In addition to these opportunities outside of the classroom, the students have been learning a lot in the classroom as well. In religion, the students have spent time diving deep into the Beatitudes (Matthew 5). In science, we have just finished our first unit, which focuses on the steps of the scientific method. In social studies, students are learning about our colonial heritage and the Revolutionary War. In math, the sixth graders are almost through with the chapter on fractions,

and the fifth graders just completed their first chapter over place value and the number system. In fifth grade reading, our reading groups are up and running in an attempt to get each student reading books and material that is specific to their reading level.
