Dear Parents,

At the awards ceremony last year, I told you all that I wanted our school to be able to provide special services in the areas of speech and occupational therapy. I also said that we're working toward strengthening our math curriculum so more of our students are placed in the advanced math class in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. Next, I said that we want to provide a more individualized reading approach to meet our students at their learning levels.

I'm proud to tell you that we are on track to do all of those things. It's taken a quarter to get everything established, and we know it will be an ongoing effort. Here's what we've done so far:

- After the Ohio Department of Education approved our school application, we are now a Jon Peterson provider – any of our students who are on an IEP (Individual Education Plan) can apply to receive a state scholarship that will cover speech, occupational therapy, or physical therapy services.
- 2. Our fall MAP scores are already showing an improvement in our overall math scores. Our new Go Math curriculum is what our students will be
