Most of you are probably aware of the recent, tragic school shooting in Parkland, Florida. It's unfortunate, but necessary that even our school be prepared if such an event were to ever happen here, God forbid. Yesterday the students conducted their second lockdown drill of the year. The ALICE training that we use was adopted several years ago by all the schools in Paulding county. ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) offers a more proactive way to handle the threat of an aggressive intruder or active shooter event. ALICE tactics have become the accepted response, versus the traditional "lockdown only" approach.

Amount of pages to read each night:


preschool: parent reads a book to the student	3rd grade: 20 pages




Kick the Dust Up All Family – Students and Parents Dance
