Friday we will kick off our Fall fundraiser. Club's Choice Fundraising is offering some individual and group incentives to encourage participation. This event will run through Monday, September 11th. Delivery of ordered items will be October 10th. **Please collect payment when your customers place their orders.** Our fundraiser helps keep our tuition affordable.

**Absence** - When your child is going to be absent or late, please call the school office (419-263-2114) before 8:40 a.m. Otherwise, our secretary will be calling you to verify your child's absence.

**Weather Delays:**

If Paulding is delayed 2 hours for weather reasons, and Wayne Trace is on the regular schedule, Paulding buses will run 2 hours late. You may bring your child in, safety permitting, or you may let them ride the Paulding bus running on the 2 hour delay. They are not counted tardy when it is a weather related 2 hour delay. If Wayne Trace is delayed 2 hours and Paulding is not delayed, Divine Mercy students arriving on Paulding buses will be placed in a monitored study hall in the Paulding school until they can be transported to Divine Mercy.

If Paulding closes for weather reasons, and Wayne Trace remains open, there will be **no bus** service to Divine Mercy. If you choose not to bring your child to school, they will not be counted absent for that day.

**3-hour delays** - Wayne Trace will implement the 3-hour delay when necessary. **A 3-hour delay would extend the school day by 1 hour, with dismissal at 4:25.**

**Lunch Money** - Just a reminder that you need to send in money with your child if they will be buying hot lunch. You may send in a lump sum of money and this will be placed on your child's lunch account. Lunch (which includes milk) is \$2.70. If your child wishes to purchase milk only, it is \$.50 a carton. If paying by check please make the check payable to Payne Elementary. Remember to place your child's money in a marked envelope that includes:

**Their name, grade level, and the amount of money that is enclosed.**

Please do your best to keep your child's lunch account current. A notice will be sent home with your child when more money is needed in their account.

**Free and Reduced Lunch Forms** - This form was in the packet of papers you received at open house or on the first day of school. If you have not yet returned this form, please take time to look at the income chart to see if you qualify. No child on Free and Reduced Lunches will be singled out at lunchtime. There is no difference in how the count is taken or how they are served to the students. Federal Assistance funds our Title 1 reading and math programs.

The more students who qualify for free/reduced lunches help secure federal funding for our Title 1 reading and math programs. These programs are a very important part of our daily curriculum. Our students depend on these programs to boost their academic skills in all areas. **Please return the forms to school by this Friday, August 25th.**

You can have your family name listed on a tee sign for a \$15 donation and/or a cart sign for a \$25 donation. To purchase a "Tee or Cart Sign," you can send in your donation along with your family name to the school. **Please have all Tee/Cart sign information into school by Wednesday, September 6th.** If you have any questions call the school office.

If you received **Honeywell Instant Alerts** last year, you should still be receiving them this year too. This is used to notify you of school delays. New students and any new kindergarten family will be added to the system, using the phone number you provided during registration. Any newly registered family, and any new family who is coming from Payne Elementary is already in the system too. **If you do not receive a notification during our first school delay, let us know so we can resolve the issue.**

1. go to the website: <https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/> and click **First-Time Registrant**
2. **ONCE REGISTERED**...go back to the homepage and click on "Services/Programs" near the top of the page
3. The first option that will come up on your screen is "Protecting God's Children® for Adults" and you should click under that paragraph where it says "More..."
